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### Job Summary

Regular, Full-Time, RCUH Non-Civil Service position with the School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology, Center for Microbial Oceanography: Research and Education (C-MORE) located in Honolulu, Hawaii. Continuation of employment is dependent upon program/operational needs, satisfactory work performance, and availability of funds.

MINIMUM MONTHLY SALARY: Salary commensurate with qualifications.

**DUTIES:** Works as part of a team to increase scientific literacy in Microbial Oceanography. Designs and implements educational outreach material and activities for K-12 students and the public at large and will train pre-service and in-service teachers of these materials. Designs and implements educational and professional development opportunities for C-MORE students. Develops and strengthens partnerships with existing outreach programs, schools, and community colleges in Oceanography and related fields. Compiles required data on the Center's education programs. Will initially co-design and co-lead these duties and responsibilities. Within six (6) months, will be expected to take a lead role in these duties and responsibilities.

Up to one (0-1) year of shipboard and/or laboratory experience. Up to one (0-1) year of experience communicating with diverse groups. Up to one (0-1) year of experience using technology in educational settings. **ABIL/KNOW/SKILLS:** Strong working knowledge of Hawaii's marine environment. Able to have a strong sense of time management. Able to possess strong skills in project management. Able to possess strong oral and written communication skills. **Post Offer/Employment Condition:** Must be able to pass post-offer criminal background check. **PHYSICAL/MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS:** Able to work on a research cruise for up to four (4) days at a time.
