The first Maui County Sustainability Fair will be held at Maui Community College on Tuesday, 1 August 2006 from 3 p.m. through 6:30 p.m. This event is being held in conjunction with the Islands of the World IX Conference of the International Small Islands Studies Association (ISISA), which will take place at Maui Community College 31 July through 2 August 2006. The theme of this year's conference is ***Sustainable Islands ~ Sustainable Strategies***.

The objective of this event is to highlight sustainable practices, techniques, and tools that are applicable to small islands communities and environments. It will provide an informal setting to promote exchange of information and ideas among interested groups. This is a unique opportunity to network with scholars, researchers, and representatives from over 100 island nations who attend the ISISA conferences. This event is open to the public as well as to the conference participants. All groups involved with sustainability issues and solutions are encouraged to participate, including those affiliated the University of Hawai`i and other educational institutions, cultural organizations, clubs, non-profit organizations, foundations, governmental agencies, and businesses.

The fair will be housed in a tent on the lawn in the middle of the MCC campus. Set up begins at noon. There will be a \$20 registration fee for businesses. Each participating group will have one table and two chairs, unless specific requests are made in advance. Please avoid distributing materials that cannot be recycled or reused.
