Opportunity Description:

C3 has three vacancies for well-qualified graduates to work as field-based interns on the C3 Fiji and South Pacific Islands Programme. We will be working with a remote island community on the Great Sea Reef, the third largest barrier reef in the world, to implement locally-driven marine resource management activities.

The first phase of this work will be the documentation of traditional knowledge of the reef and its fishery resources (with an emphasis on threatened species such as Humphead Wrasse (*Cheilinus undulatus*) and Giant Groupers (*Epinephalus lanceolatus*)) from village elders to ensure that this valuable information is not lost forever. We hope to use this information to implement effective management practices.

We will be working with the Global Socioeconomic Monitoring Initiative for Coastal Management (SocMon) through regional and local partners to facilitate community-based socioeconomic monitoring. Household and community level data will be collected to inform dependence on coral reef resources, perceptions of resource conditions, threats to marine and coastal resources, and support for marine management strategies such as marine protected areas
