Job Description:

The selected candidate will provide project support for environmental projects, related to commercial, State, Municipal and DoD clients. Candidate will be responsible for field work (including soil and groundwater sampling, drilling supervision, and soil gas sample collection), environmental construction oversight, and preparation of technical reports.

Job Requirements:

The ideal candidate will have anywhere from entry level to 2 years of environmental consulting experience. You must reside in Hawaii. An engineering or environmental background is required. Preferred experience (but not required) includes CERCLA RI/FS, preliminary assessment/site inspections, Phase I ESA (ASTM) and Phase II site characterization (subsurface investigations), and environmental construction oversight. An understanding of DOH HEER Office Technical Guidance Manual (TGM) is helpful, but not required.

It is preferred that candidates have some experience in technical report preparation and previous field experience or interest. It is also preferred that candidates have the ability to perform environmental construction oversight, soil and groundwater sampling, and environmental drilling operations. You must have the ability to work independently or with limited supervision on field projects. Experience or willingness to become certified in Asbestos and Lead Inspection is preferred.

Enthusiasm, resourcefulness, and a positive attitude is a plus. The successful candidate is able to communicate effectively and make evaluated decisions for the betterment of the client and the company. Strong verbal and written communication skills required.

BS in Environmental, Civil, or Chemical Engineering (EIT preferred) is preferred. BS in Geology or Environmental Sciences will also be considered. The following training is helpful, but not required: OSHA 40-hour HAZWOPER Training, and OSHA Hazardous Waste Operations Management and Supervisor Training, Asbestos Inspector certification, and Lead-based paint inspector certification.

The physical demands of this position require the ability to handle general lifting associated with field sampling. The work environment will consist of an office environment as well as working in the field.

This is a part-time position, initially expected to be 20+/- hours per week. Minimal travel required, expected to be predominantly within Hawaii.
