Duties include: Assist in land management, reforestation, controlling non-native plants through mechanical and chemical control. Desirable skills: This position requires use of non-restricted herbicides to regularly control invasive species. Safe herbicide handling and application are necessary. Should be able to maintain and operate small engine equipment and have familiarity with construction and maintenance of fence lines, trails and roads. Knowledge of Hawaiian history, culture, native plants, wildlife, and mountain areas on Maui is important.
